

**TOP GUN SENIOR SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION  
HALL OF FAME  
INDUCTION CRITERIA**

1. **Categories:**

- a. The association will establish criteria to recognize outstanding senior softball players within the following categories. Honorary; Manager; and Player:
- b. The board shall select a maximum of three (3) eligible recipients each calendar year. This number shall be a combined total of the three categories.
- c. Eligible players may be nominated and elected for more than one category.
- d. Players that are not selected will remain eligible every year after submittal.

2. **Hall of Fame Nominees:**

- a. Any Honorary, Manager, or Player nominee may be nominated for consideration by any combination of teammates, fellow coaches, or a member of the Top Gun Board of Directors.

3. **Hall of Fame Categories Qualifications:**

a. **HONORARY:**

- i. Any of the original members of the Top Gun Senior Softball Association
- ii. Any Board member serving ten (10) or more year's
- iii. Sponsor: Any significant sponsor to the Association
- iv. Nominees must meet one or more criteria

b. **MANAGER:**

- i. Any manager that has coached a Top Gun team that won one or more World Championships (Spring, World, and/or Winter) or a Tournament of Champion
- ii. Manager shall have won a total of six (6) or more major tournaments in any age group or classification.
- iii. Any manager that has managed a Top Gun team for a minimum of five (5) years at any age group or classification.
- iv. Must meet all criteria

c. **PLAYER:**

- i. Played on a Top Gun team for ten (10) or more years in any age group or rating. The year total does not have to be consecutive.
- ii. Received fifteen (15) or more All-Tournament selections.
- iii. Won six (6) or more major tournaments in any age group or rating.

iv. Must meet all criteria

4. **Special Circumstances:**

- a. The Board of Directors may nominate and consider for induction any deserving Manager and/or Player that may not meet all of the requirements as outlined in this Hall of Fame criteria but has contributed immensely to the overall success of the Top Gun Senior Softball Association.

5. **Hall of Fame Submittal dates and process:**

- a. Nominations may be submitted by any individual associated with senior softball and is either currently or has previously participated on a Top Gun Senior Softball team.
- b. Any member of the Top Gun Board of Directors may submit the nomination of a qualified player for consideration.
- c. Nominations must be submitted to the Top Gun Board of Directors Chairman by the last day of February in the awarding year. (i.e. Nominations for the 2009 season must be received by February 28, 2010).
- d. A two-thirds majority vote of the seated members of the Top Gun Senior Softball Association Board of Directors will qualify an inductee.
- e. Inductees will be notified in June and will be honored at an appropriate Hall of Fame banquet in July.
- f. Inductees will receive a suitable plaque for their possession. The inductees name will appear on a Top Gun Senior Softball Association Hall of Fame perpetual plaque, and the inductee will have the opportunity to purchase a Top Gun Hall of Fame ring.
